Schoppel Cashmere Queen	3.75 mm (approx US 5)	26 sts x 26 rows = 4" x 4"	3.5" x 45"	3.5" x 60"
35% Cashmere, 45% Merino Wool, 20% Silk; 153 yds / 50g				
HiKoo Kenzie	3.75 mm (approx US 5)	23 sts x 24 rows = 4" x 4"	4" x 45"	4" x 60"
50% New Zealand Merino, 25% Nylon, 10% Angora, 10% Alpaca, 5% Silk Noils; 160 yds / 50g				
Schulana Lanalpaco	6 mm (approx US 10)	18 sts x 13 rows = 4" x 4"	5" x 45"	5" x 60"
55% Alpaca, 35% Cotton, 10% Wool; 120 yds / 50g				
HiKoo® Simplinatural	4 mm (approx US 6)	23 sts x 15 rows = 4" x 4"	4" x 45"	4" x 60"
40% Baby Alpaca, 40% Fine Merino Wool, 20% Mulberry Silk; 183 yds / 100g

SKILL LEVEL: Experienced

SIZE & MATERIALS:

Yarn: One hank or ball each of MC and CC (for loop or scarf).

Note: Garment is reversible, and the same amount of yarn is used in each color. MC and CC are simply used as reference in pattern.

Additional Notions: Tapestry needle; 1 - 2 large buttons (for Loop)

To save time, check your gauge and read all instructions thoroughly before beginning.

STITCH PATTERN:

Reversible 2-Color Brioche Rib:

(Set Up) Row 1A (CC): K3, (k1, p1) 4x, p1, (k1, p1) 4x, k3. Do not turn work. Slide sts to beg of row with same side facing.

Row 1B (MC): P3, (k1, purl into the row below in next st) 4x, p1, (k1, purl into the row below in next st) 4x, p3. Turn work.

Row 2A (CC): P3, (k1, purl into the row below in next st) 4x, p1, (k1, purl into the row below in next st) 4x, p3. Do not turn work. Slide sts to beg of row with same side facing.

Row 2B (MC): K3, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 4x, p1, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 4x, k3. Turn work.

Row 3A (CC): K3, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 4x, p1, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 4x, k3. Do not turn work. Slide sts to beg of row with same side facing.

Repeat Rows 1B - 3A for pat.

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INSTRUCTIONS:

With MC, CO 23 sts.

Beginning Ribbing:

Row 1: K3, (k1, p1) 4x, p1, (k1, p1) 4x, k3.

Rows 2 - 7: Repeat Row 1. Do not cut yarn.

Two-Color Cable:

Set Up Row 8: Switch to CC and work Row 1A (CC) Do not turn work. Slide sts to beg of row with same side facing.

Rows 9 - 23: Work Rows 1B - 3A of Reversible Brioche Rib Pattern 3x, and Rows 1B - 2B 1x.

Row 24 (Cable Cross Row): With CC, K3, sl4 sts to CN and hold to back of work, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 2x, working on sts from CN (knit into row below in next st, p1) 2x, p1, sl4 sts to CN and hold to front of work, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 2x, working on sts from CN (knit into row below in next st, p1) 2x, k3. Do not turn work. Slide sts to beg of row with same side facing.



To finish as one-wrap Loop with buttonhole:

Repeat Rows 9 - 24 until work measures 43.5", ending after working Row 22 (Row 2A of Reversible Brioche Rib Pattern).

Buttonhole:

Row 1: With MC, K3, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 3x, bind off 4 sts, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 3x, k3. Turn work.

Row 2: With CC, K3, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 3x, in next st lift CC loop from below onto left needle and knit MC and CC sts

together, CO 4 sts, (knit into row below in next st, p1) 3x, k3. Turn work.

Cut MC yarn, leaving a 6" tail for weaving in.

Ending Ribbing (with CC):

Switch to CC.

Row 1: K3, (k1, p1) 4x, p1, (k1, p1) 4x, k3.

Rows 2 - 7: Repeat Row 1.

Bind off all sts.

To finish as multi-wrap Scarf without buttonhole:

Repeat Rows 9 - 24 until work measures 58.5" (or to desired length), ending after working Row 24 *without working the Cable* (Row 3A of Reversible Brioche Rib Pattern).

Cut MC yarn, leaving a 6" tail for weaving in.

Ending Ribbing (with CC):

Switch to CC.

Row 1: K3, (k1, p1) 4x, p1, (k1, p1) 4x, k3.

Rows 2 - 7: Repeat Row 1.

Bind off all sts.

FINISHING:

Weave in yarn tails.

For Loop: Sew a single button on one side of the scarf (or two - one on either side of the scarf) at the point where the Beginning Ribbing and CC meet.
